The Open Meeting of the North County USBC Association will be held May 19th, 2019, starting at 11:00 AM. We will hold elections for the following officers, directors and delegates. There is a copy of the Nomination Form attached for the use by any Association member wishing to submit his/her name and resume for a position on the North County USBC Association Board of Directors or National /State Delegate representing NCUSBC.

Offices, which are up for election at the 2019 Annual Meeting, are:

President

Second Vice President

Sergeant – At - Arms

Five Adult Directors #1, 3, 5, 7, 9

Three Youth Directors #1, 3, 5

Four National Delegates and two alternate Delegates for the 2020 USBC Convention

Six Adult State Delegates and Four Youth State Delegates (2 Adult, 2 Youth and one alternate youth)
for the 2020 California State USBC Convention

The following information from the North County USBC Association Bylaws explains the qualifications required to run for the above Officer and Director positions.

Article V. Board of Directors - Management, Section B, Eligibility.

A candidate for the Board must be:

- 1. Adult. A USBC member in good standing of the Association at the time of election and throughout their term.**
Youth. USBC youth member bowling in USBC Leagues within the association's jurisdiction.
- 2. Elected or appointed without regard to race, religion, sex, sexual orientation, disability, national origin, or age other than the minimum age of 14, unless state laws mandate a specific age, and be reasonably representative of the membership.**
 - a. Any member of the board authorized to sign contracts or acting as a signatory on association accounts must be a minimum age of 18.**
 - b. At least 20% of the board must be directors representing youth.**
 - c. A maximum of three bowling center proprietors may serve on the Board at one time. A proprietor is an individual who is the owner, partner, or corporate officer of a bowling center or group of bowling centers. Excluded from the definition of proprietor is an individual who owns 25% or less of the equity shares, or who is inactive in the management of the bowling center and remains so during a term as an officer or director.**

Additional eligibility requirements, if any, are to be approved by the board, adult members and youth representatives.

Section C. Election of Directors

All Directors are:

- 1. Elected by the board, adult members and youth representatives.**
- 2. Elected by majority vote, unless plurality vote is adopted, by the board, adult members and youth representative. They are elected by Plurality vote.**
- 3. A slate.**
- 4. Nominations from the floor.**

At least 20% of the total number of board members must be directors representing youth.

Qualifications must be submitted in a format specified by the board.

Article VI. Officers, Section B, Election.

The board, adult members and youth representatives determine the election process...

- ⊙ Officers are elected by a majority vote of the board, adult members and youth representatives, present and voting from:**
 - a. A slate.**
 - b. Nominations from the floor.**

Qualifications must be submitted in a format specified by the board.

When a candidate is nominated from the floor, the signed, written consent of the candidate along with three (3) copies of the nomination form and resume must be filed with the Chairman, Nominating Committee prior to the nomination **and** prior to the start of the Annual Meeting. The nominator shall be prepared to read the qualifications for the nominee.

Youth bowlers must be fourteen (14) years of age or older as of August 1st of the current season and be a USBC Certified member and remain an eligible Youth member during his/her term, except due to age.

All adult youth representatives must wear their RVP (Registered Volunteer Program) badges when working with youth or at adult/youth events.

Four delegates and two alternates will be elected to the 2020 National USBC Convention.

Six Adult State Delegates and Four Youth State Delegates (2 Adult, 2 Youth and one alternate youth) will be elected to the 2020 California State USBC Convention.
