2025-2026 Youth Championship Tournament Rules

RULES AND REGULATIONS: All USBC playing rules apply except those listed below govern this tournament.

DRESS CODE: While competing, proper attire will be required. Unacceptable attire includes but not limited to: tank tops, spaghetti straps, bare midriffs, cut offs, short shorts, legging/yoga pants, garments with holes or ANY OBSCENE OR GANG CLOTHING. Skirts must be knee length or longer. Shorts and skirts must be no more than four (4) inches above the knee. Hat and headphones will NOT be permitted. All issues regarding proper attire will be decided upon by the tournament management.

ELIGIBILITY: This tournament is open to all North County USBC Association (NCUSBCA) Youth members that are currently participating in a North County Youth league. All bowlers must hold a current membership card.

ENTRY FEE: \$20.00 per event. \$40 for both doubles and singles events. (Lineage - \$9, Expense - \$2, Prize Fund - \$9). NO refunds after deadline date.

TOURNAMENT EVENTS: The tournament shall consist of two events: Doubles (any combination of 2 bowlers) and Singles Event.

DIVISIONS:

	Singles	Doubles
1	69 and under	139 and under
2	70-100	140-200
3	101 and higher	201 and higher

Divisions are by average only. If there are fewer than two in any division, bowlers will be combined with the next higher division. Divisions may be adjusted to accommodate bowlers registered.

ENTERING AVERAGE: Averages will be verified using bowl.com. Entering averages shall be as follows:

1. Highest average from 2024-2025. If none,
2. Highest average from 2023-2024. If none,
3. Current average (consisting of 12 games).
4. If none of the above, bowler will use an average of 220.

HANDICAP: Based on 90% of the difference of 200 and entering average. It is the responsibility of the adult leader to verify their average.

RULE 319: All elements of Rule 319a-c apply. Rule 319d-f shall be exempted.

CHECK IN: All bowlers must check in thirty (30) minutes prior to squad time.

TARDY OR ABSENT BOWLERS: In the event a bowler is tardy, they may still participate starting in the frame currently being bowled. Previous frames will be scored with a zero. Absentee scores shall be a 0 for the game.

GENERAL INFORMATION: Any returned checks will incur a \$35.00 service fee plus any bank charges.

EQUIPMENT: Once competition has started, altering the surface of bowling balls using abrasives, cleaners, or polish is prohibited. The outer surface may only be cleaned with a dry towel. If there is something on the surface of the ball that cannot be cleaned/removed with a clean dry towel, an approved cleaner can be used, but ONLY with the approval of a tournament official. Bowling balls with no thumb hole must have scribe mark near the intended center of the palm.

SUBSTITUTIONS: Substitutions are permitted in each event (Doubles and Singles) and shall bowl in the same position as the person replaced. Once a substitution has been placed, changes will not be made. Adult leader is responsible for the substitute bowler's average verification.

YOUTH AWARDS & PRIZES: Scores bowled qualify for USBC awards as outlined in Chapter 3 of the USBC Playing Rules. All scholarship prizes will be submitted through the SMART program.

PROTESTS & APPEALS: USBC_Rule 329 applies.

DISQUALIFICATION: Alcoholic beverages may not be consumed. Smoking is not allowed by any youth participating in the tournament. Food and beverages are allowed but must be kept out of the bowler's area.

COACHING: No coaching is permitted during the tournament. No yelling will be tolerated. **NOTE:** No one other than tournament bowlers or those working the tournament are allowed in the bowler's area.

A Contract of Mutual Responsibility: To the Tournament Director of this Tournament, acting for those whose names appear on the entry form: I hereby enter those listed in the events, indicated and all agree to abide by the tournament and playing rules and regulations prescribed by the NCUSBCA, including all provisions set forth on the entry form, together with the playing rules and regulations of the United States Bowling Congress. Entry fees as shown on this entry form are herewith enclosed for the events entered. The entrants, whose names appear hereon or their authorized substitutes, hereby agree that the NCUSBCA, its Officers and other agents shall be liable only to the extent of returning entry fees if and when this Team shall be prevented from bowling any event in this Tournament, which may be brought about by fires, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties or other causes beyond the control of the NCUSBCA. "Premature termination of the Tournament brought about by war, national emergency causes relating thereto or there from fires, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties or other reasons beyond the control of the NCUSBCA shall cause the foregoing prize schedule to be prorated in accordance with the number of entrants who have bowled in each of the respective events up to the time of termination."
