2025-2026 Masters & Queens Tournament Rules

RULES AND REGULATIONS: All USBC playing rules apply and govern this tournament, except those exempted below.

ELIGIBILITY: This tournament is open to all USBC-certified adult members. Participating bowlers must hold a current North County USBC Association membership card. The Queens tournament is open to only women though women may bowl in the Masters tournament.

ENTRY FEE: \$125.00 (Expenses: \$30.00, Prize Fund - \$95.00)

TOURNAMENT EVENTS:

Masters	Queens
<p>Qualifying Round (based on 35 bowlers)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Each bowler shall bowl 5 games, all on the same lanes. In the event of a tie for the last qualifying position, a 10th frame roll-off (on the same lane) shall be bowled until the tie is broken. The top 8 bowlers shall bowl 3 games. The top 5 bowlers will bowl in the final round. <p>Final Round</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The final round shall be a staircase format with top 5 bowlers (#5 will bowl #4, winner will bowl #3, winner will bowl #2, winner will bowl #1). If there are less than 30 entries, after the initial 5 games, we will proceed to the staircase format. 	<p>Qualifying Round (based on 35 bowlers)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Each bowler shall bowl 5 games, all on the same lanes. In the event of a tie for the last qualifying position, a 10th frame roll-off (on the same lane) shall be bowled until the tie is broken. The top 8 bowlers shall bowl 3 games. The top 5 bowlers will bowl in the final round. <p>Final Round</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The final round shall be a staircase format with top 5 bowlers (#5 will bowl #4, winner will bowl #3, winner will bowl #2, winner will bowl #1). If there are less than 30 entries, after the initial 5 games, we will proceed to the staircase format. If there are less than 10 entries, women bowlers may choose to bowl in the Masters or receive a full refund.

RULE 319: Rule 319d-f shall be exempted.

DRESS CODE: While competing, proper attire will be required. Unacceptable attire includes but not limited to: tank tops, spaghetti straps, bare midriffs, cut offs, short shorts, legging/yoga pants, garments with holes or ANY OBSCENE CLOTHING. Skirts must be knee length or longer. Shorts and skorts must be no more than four (4) inches above the knee. Devices that produce audible sound to anyone other than the user are not permitted during tournament play. All issues regarding proper attire and technology will be decided upon by the tournament manager.

CHECK-IN: Check-in begins sixty (60) minutes prior to the squad time. Bowlers must check in 15 minutes prior to squad time.

TARDY BOWLERS: In the event a bowler is tardy, they may still participate starting in the frame currently being bowled. Previous frames will be scored with a zero.

GENERAL INFORMATION: Any returned checks will incur a \$35.00 service fee plus any bank charges.

EQUIPMENT: Once competition has started, altering the surface of bowling balls using abrasives, cleaners, or polish is prohibited. The outer surface may only be cleaned with a dry towel. Bowling balls with no thumb hole must have scribe mark near the intended center of the palm. All holes in the ball must be used except if using a house ball.

PRIZE MONEY: Distribution of the prize fund shall be based on final number of entries.

ENTRY FEES & REFUNDS: All entries must be paid in full and prior to the deadline. No refunds will be given after the deadline, except as listed above in the Queens event.

PROTESTS & APPEALS: USBC_Rule 329 applies.

A Contract of Mutual Responsibility: To the Tournament Director of this Tournament, acting for those whose names appear on the entry form: I hereby enter those listed in the events, indicated and all agree to abide by the tournament and playing rules and regulations prescribed by the NCUSBCA, including all provisions set forth on the entry form, together with the playing rules and regulations of the United States Bowling Congress. Entry fees as shown on this entry form are herewith enclosed for the events entered. The entrants, whose names appear hereon or their authorized substitutes, hereby agree that the NCUSBCA, its Officers and other agents shall be liable only to the extent of returning entry fees if and when this Team shall be prevented from bowling any event in this Tournament, which may be brought about by fires, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties or other causes beyond the control of the NCUSBCA. "Premature termination of the Tournament brought about by war, national emergency causes relating thereto or there from fires, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties or other reasons beyond the control of the NCUSBCA shall cause the foregoing prize schedule to be prorated in accordance with the number of entrants who have bowled in each of the respective events up to the time of termination."
